One resident's water service will be disconnected if payment (or an agreement) is not received.

Supt. Tysor reported that the snow removal vehicles are fixed and running again. Sites to dump the snow are dwindling and the crew is in the process of moving the snow piles attempting to make more room for the predicted new snow. Sand is also getting low in supply.

The Mayor commented that, on behalf of the Council, he wishes to commend Bill and his crew for the great job of snow removal. It meant that the crew worked many additional hours, sacrificing their holiday plans, and all is very much appreciated.

The City appreciates the financial funding from the Local United Funds: Pool-\$1,550.00; the Major/Minor Program-\$171.00; and City Park Equipment-\$20.00.

Hemphill commented that the City should be looking for a different street sweeper with a pressurized cab.
